

# **Regional Economic Recovery Work Plan FAQ**

**Who is eligible to apply for stimulus funding?**

**Has the total funding amount for Sacramento been pre-determined or is it based on the amount requested through the regional proposal?**

**Where can I find more information on the categories? How do I know which category I fit in?**  
For more information regarding the stimulus funding categories, please refer to the Sacramento NAACP website.

**If I qualify in more than one category do I need to submit more than one proposal?**

**How long can my proposal be?**  
Proposal should be no more than 2 pages, single spaced and submitted on company letterhead.

**When is the deadline for proposal submissions?**  
All proposals must be submitted no later than March 20<sup>th</sup>.

**Where (and how) do I submit my proposal?**

**What type of financial information should I include in my proposal?**

**In my proposal, should I ask for a specific amount of money?**

**Are there any specific purposes for which funds can not be used?**  
Funds may not be used for zoos, aquariums, golf courses, swimming pools or casinos.

**Will collaborations between multiple organizations be given more weight in the funding decisioning phase?**

**What criteria will be used to evaluate the proposals?**

**Who is responsible for reviewing the submitted proposals?**

**When and how will the submitter be notified if the funding request is granted?**

**How will the actual funds be allocated? Given in a lump sum? Dispersed over a pre-set time period?**

**What is type of follow up reporting is required once the funds have been received?**

**What are the tax implications of businesses or organizations who receive this money?**

**How is information being disseminated to the public? How can we ensure that all community organizations have timely access to information?**

**Will there be a certain amount of funds specifically earmarked for disadvantages communities?**

**Are there true opportunities for small / local businesses to be considered for funding?**
