

Important information on federal stimulus proposal submissions

- All proposals must be submitted on your company letterhead.
- No more than 2 pages (single spaced) summary describing your company.
- In your proposal, assess which category your organization or business falls under. This can be determined by looking at the final stimulus bill flowchart which designates where the monies are being allocated.

You might qualify in more than one category. It is critical that you identify which category (or categories) you qualify in and include them in your proposal summary.

If you qualify in more than one category, you don't need to submit a separate proposal for each category.

- How will your company both preserve and create jobs to stimulate economic recovery?
- How will your company assist individuals most impacted by the recession?
- How will your business provide investments needed to increase economic efficiency by spurring technological advances?
- How will your business invest in transportation, environmental protection, and other infrastructure that will provide long-term economic benefits?
- How will your business contribute to stabilizing both state and local government budgets?
